



# Git for one

Install Git

http://help.github.com/

### Set up Git.

```
$ git config --global user.name "Shawn DeArmond"
```

- \$ git config --global user.email "shawn@nottellin.com"
- \$ git config --global core.editor vi

### Make this folder a Git repository

\$ cd myproject

\$ git init

Add files to the repository: one at a time or all at once.

\$ git add myfile.txt
or
\$ git add .

### Commit additions to the repository

...and then leave a comment.

# Add CHANGED FILES to the repository: one at a time or all at once.

\$ git add myfile.txt
or
\$ git add .

### Commit changes to the repository

...and then leave a comment.



# Staging

Changes don't commit unless they've been added first.






Oh sure, if you want to do it the EASY way...

Caveat: NEW files must still be added.

# Branching

If it ain't broke, you can still fix it





## Branching

Work on a nice feature, and maybe even a VERY nice feature, while your main line is still good.

### Checkout a new branch

\$ git checkout -b nice\_feature Edit the file.

\$ vi myfile.txt

### Commit the change

\$ git commit -am
"This is nice."

Go back to the "master" branch


\$ git checkout master

Fix a bug in the master branch. Maybe more than one.

```
$ vi myfile.txt
$ git commit -am
$ vi myfile.txt
$ git commit -am
```

Merge the nice\_feature branch back into the master

```
$ git checkout master
$ git merge nice_feature
```



## GUIs help too

See all commits and branches all at once

# Git for a team

### Connect to a hosted Git repository

```
$ git clone
or
$ git remote add origin
$ git push origin master
```

### Make changes to files and commit them


```
$ vi myfile.txt
$ git commit -am
$ vi myfile.txt
$ git commit -am
```

Push them up to the hosted repository

\$ git push

#### What is Media?

The Media module provides an extensible framework for managing files and multimedia assets, regardless of whether they are hosted on your own site or a 3rd party site – it is commonly refered to as a 'file browser to the internet'. It replaces the Drupal core upload field with a unified User Interface where editors and administrators can upload, manage, and reuse files and

#### One-Time Only

Setting up repository for the first time

```
git clone --branch 7.x-2.x http://git.drupal.org/project/media.git cd media
```

### Create a new issue branch

\$ git checkout -b this\_bug

Apply a patch

\$ git apply patchname.patch

Edit the file.

\$ vi media.module

# Commit the change

\$ git commit -am "This works."

# Make a patch file

```
$ git diff 7.x-2.x >
[description]-[issue-number]-
[comment-number].patch
```
